



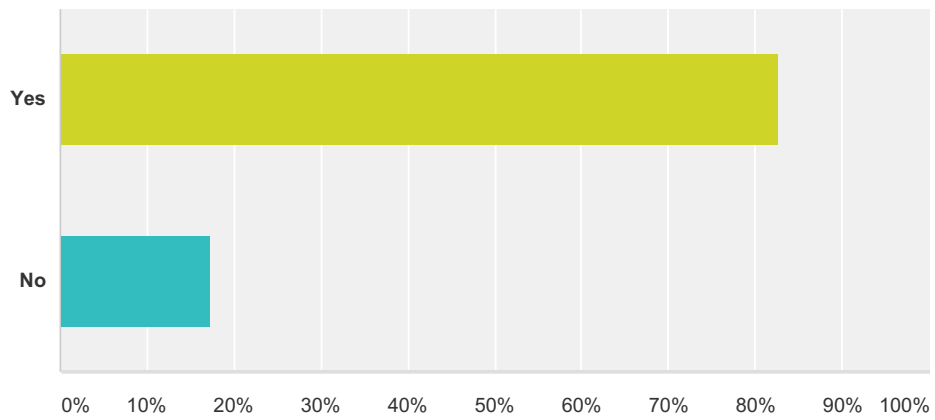
2015 Internet of Things (IoT) Survey

Q1 Have you heard the term Internet of Things?

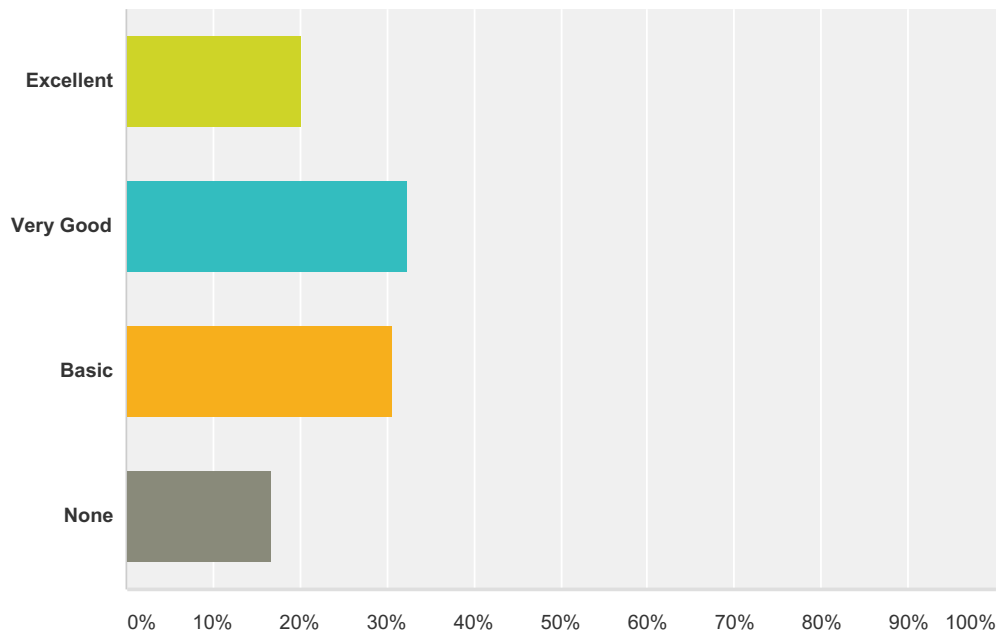

Q2 How would you rate your understanding of what the term Internet of Things means?

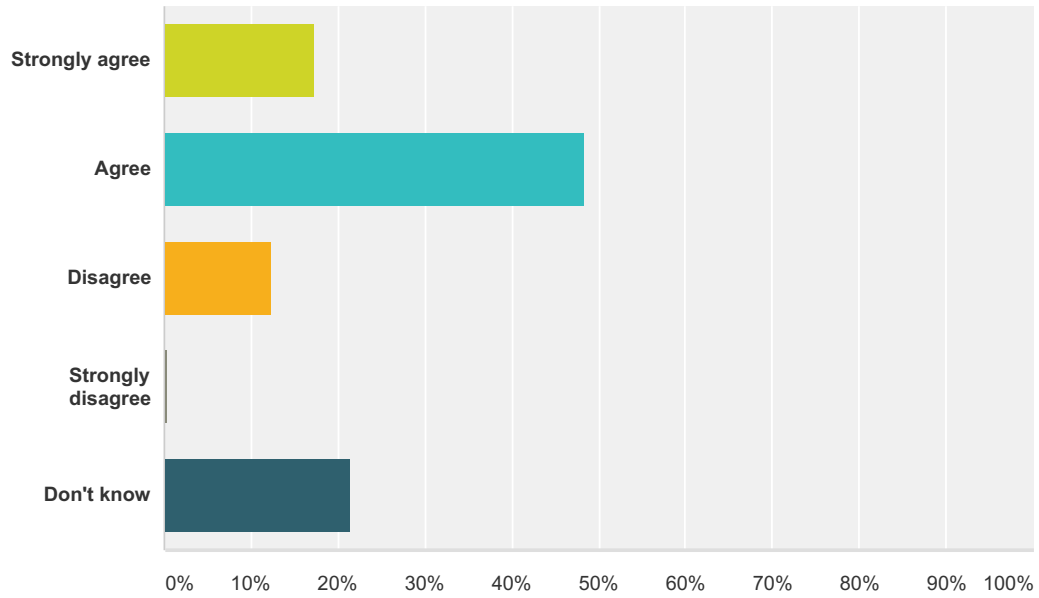

Q3 To what extent do you agree with the following statement - Smart buildings are the core application for the Internet of Things in the enterprise.

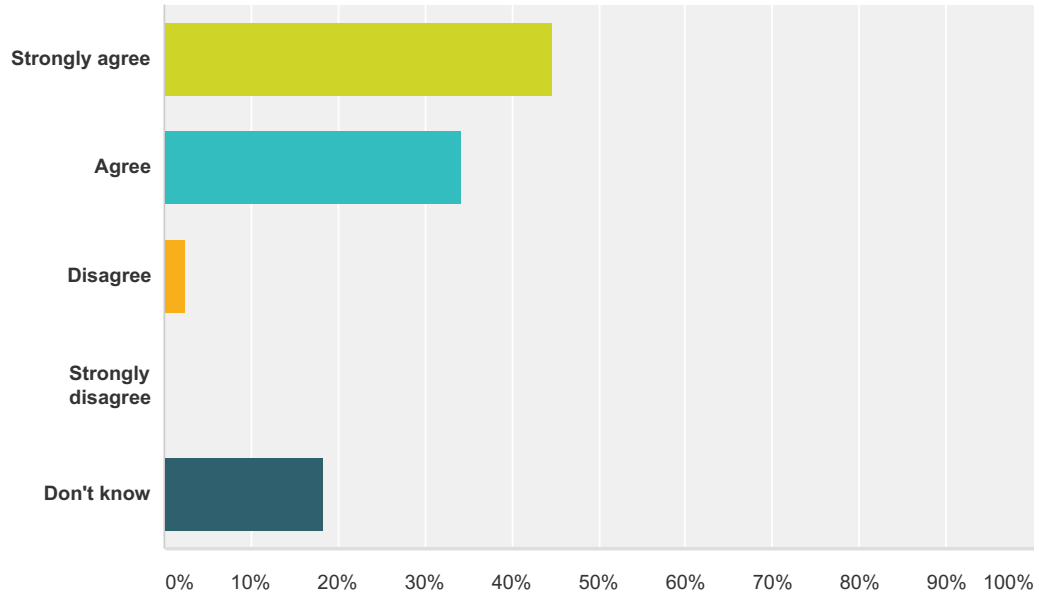

Q4 Do you believe open standards are necessary to future proof an investment in the Internet of Things?

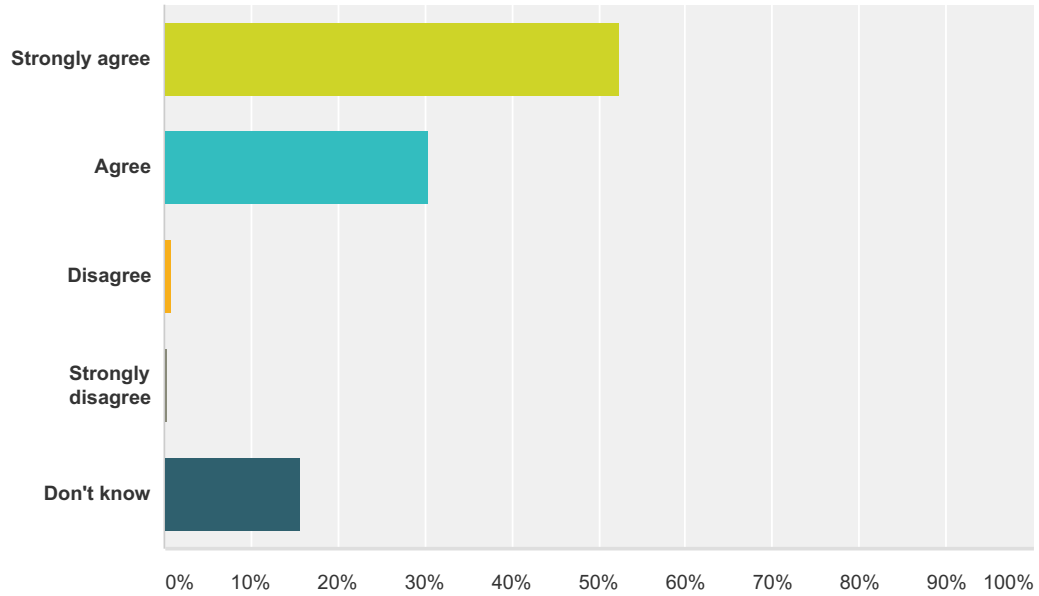
